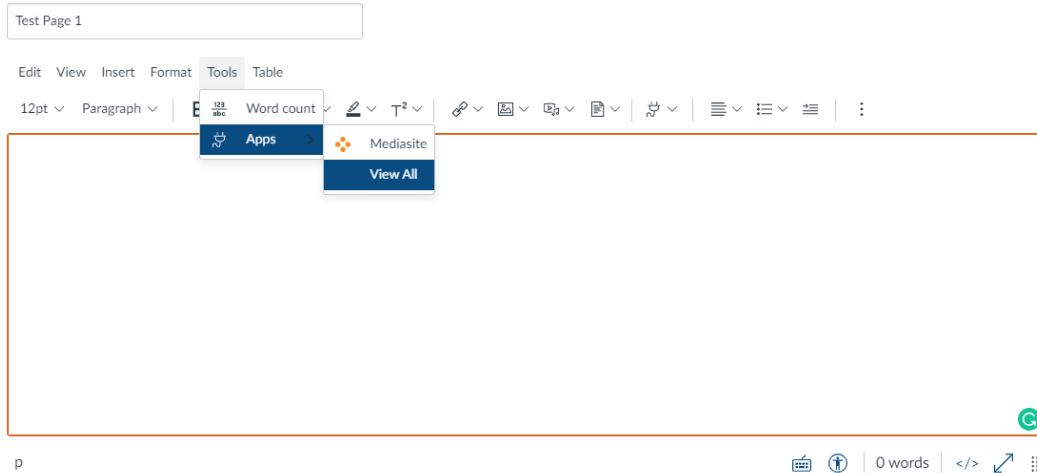


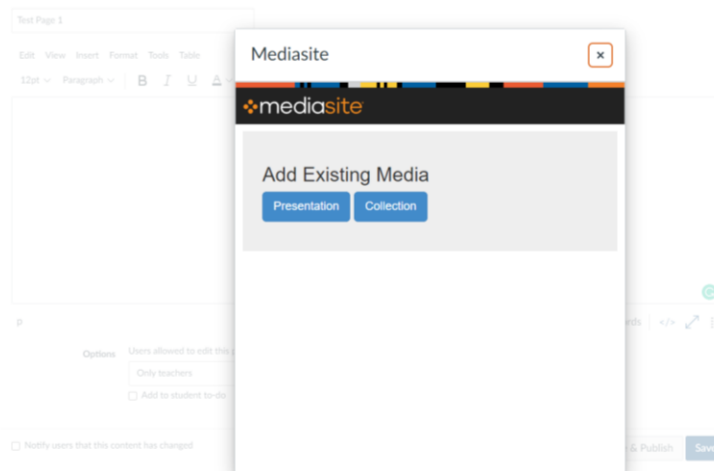
## HOW TO EMBED MEDIASITE VIDEOS/CHANNELS IN CANVAS

You can use the text editor in Canvas to embed Mediasite videos and channels on pages and discussions.

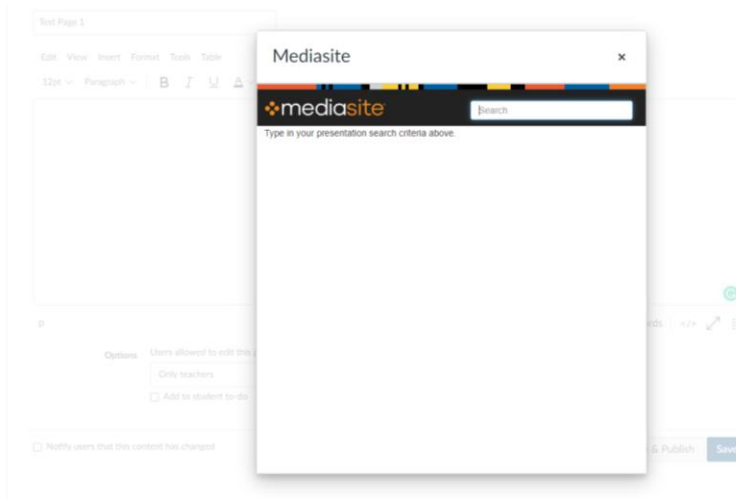
For the purpose of this tutorial, we will be editing a Page in Canvas.



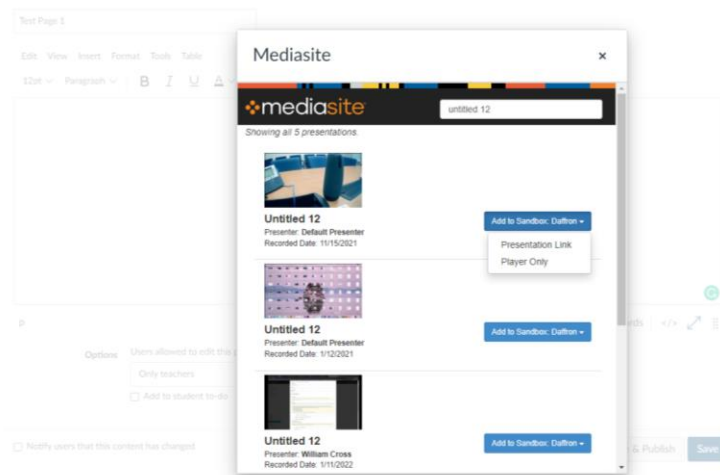
Under the “Tools” dropdown, click “Apps”. If you’ve never used the Mediasite app in canvas, you can use the “View All” button to find it in the full app list. If you have used the Mediasite app before, it should appear right away, like in the image above.



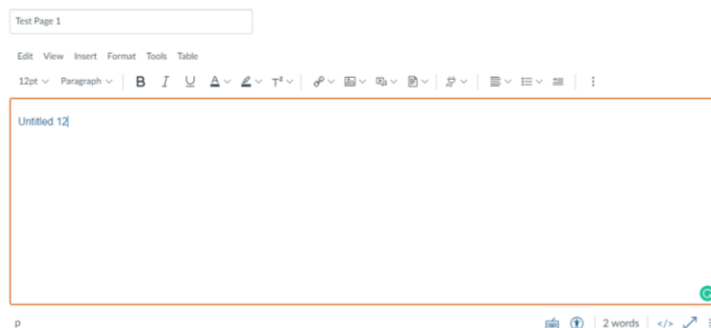
Once you click the Mediasite app, you will be given the choice to add a “Presentation” or a “Collection”. A presentation will be an individual video, while choosing collection will allow you to add a channel that contains multiple videos.



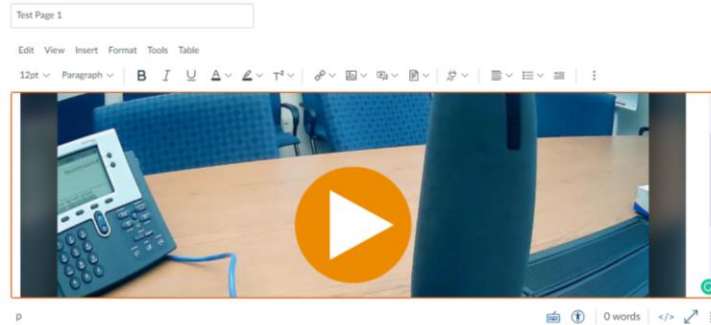
No matter which of the two options you choose, you will be brought to a search bar where you can search for the type of content you want to add.



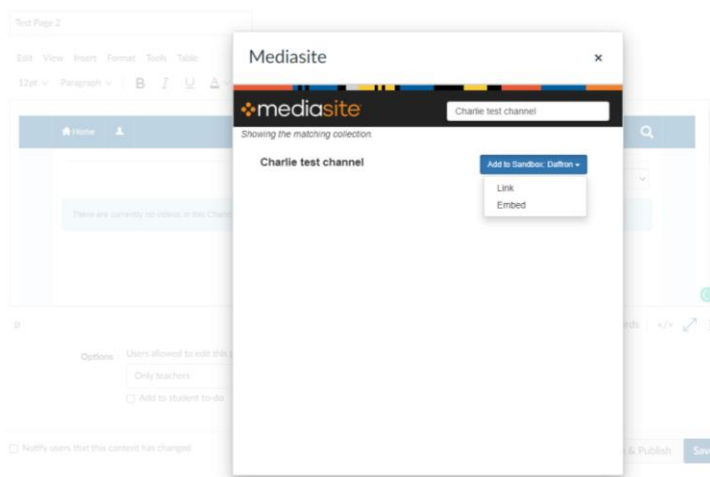
For presentations, once you've found the presentation you are looking for, use the blue button to add it to your course. When you click it, you will be given two options: "Presentation Link" and "Player Only".



Choosing "Presentation Link" will add a hyperlink to the page that will open the presentation in a new tab.



Choosing “Player Only” will embed the presentation on your page, allowing users to view it without leaving the page.



Like adding a presentation, choosing the “Collection” option will allow you to “Link” or “Embed” a catalog or channel. “Link” will add a hyperlink that will open in a new tab and “Embed” will embed the channel directly into your page.
