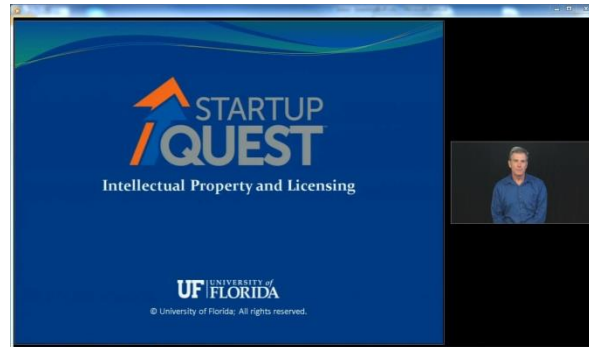
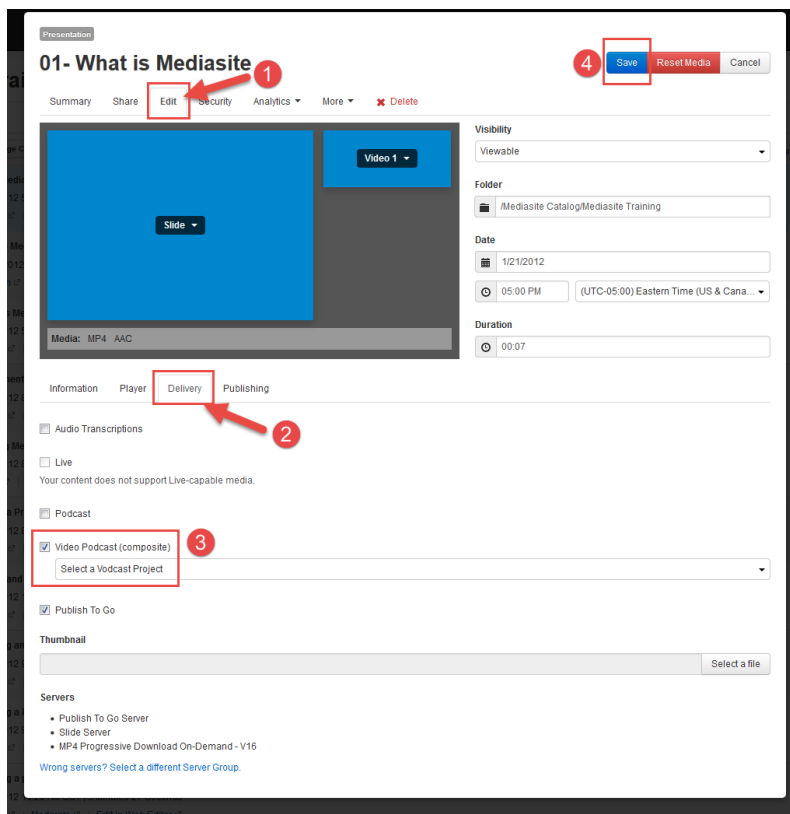


Enabling Vodcasts

Vodcast video files make downloading and sharing media easy by compiling video, audio and content into one file. The result is a video that looks like this:

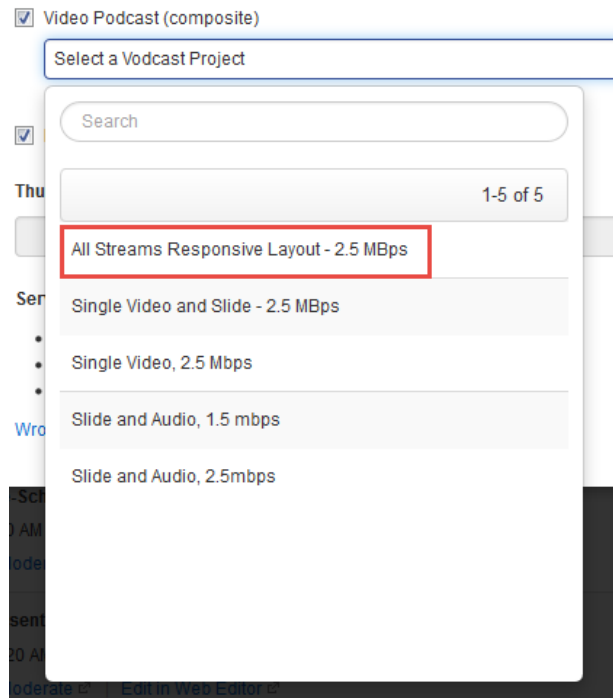


To create a vodcast, locate the presentation you'd like to share within MyMediasite:



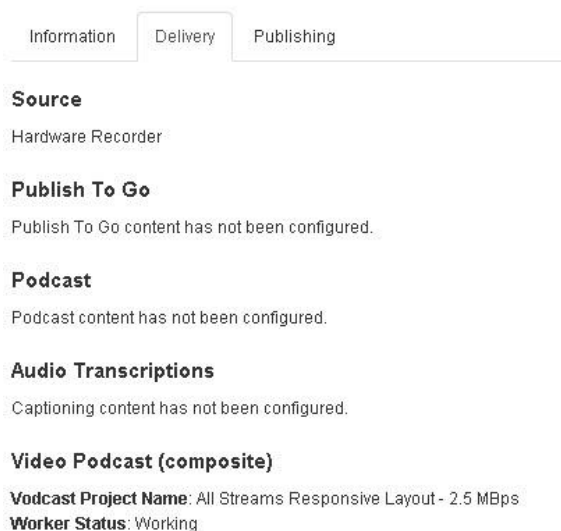
- 1.) Open your presentation and click the edit tab.
- 2.) Then click the delivery tab.

3.) Check the box next to Video Podcast (Composite) and in the drop-down menu select "All Streams Responsive Layout - 2.5 MBps"



4.) Save the presentation.

After the presentation has been saved, you can see that the Vodcast file is generating if you click on the Delivery tab. It will list the **Worker status** as "Working", as seen below:



Once the Vodcast file has finished generating, it will show a **File Server Url** under the delivery tab of the presentation. Provide this whomever you'd like to be able to download the vodcast video file. See example below:
